DESIGN

Deliverables:

1. Design documents that demonstrate criteria in NRCS practice standard have been met and are compatible with planned and applied practices.
 - a. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan.
 - b. Practice standard criteria-related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including but not limited to:
 - i. Total shade requirement
 - ii. Portability
 - iii. Additional requirements for heavy use area protection
2. Written plans and specifications including sketches and drawings as well as any applicable guide sheets shall be provided to the client that adequately describes the requirements to install the practice.
3. Preparation and documentation of operation and maintenance requirements.
4. Certification that the design meets practice standard criteria and complies with applicable laws and regulations.
5. Design modifications during installation as required.

INSTALLATION

Deliverables

1. Pre-application conference with client.
2. Application guidance as needed.
3. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original designer.
4. Certification that the application process and materials meet design requirements.

CHECK OUT

Deliverables:

1. Records of application.
 - a. Extent of practice units applied
2. Certification that the application meets NRCS standards and specifications.
3. Progress reporting.
