

**STATEMENT OF WORK**  
**Feed Management (592)**  
**IOWA**

**These deliverables apply to this individual practice. For other planned practice deliverables refer to those specific Statements of Work.**

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**DESIGN****Deliverables:**

1. Design documents that demonstrate criteria in NRCS practice standard have been met and are compatible with planned and applied practices:
  - a. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan.
  - b. List all required and/or facilitating practices.
  - c. Practice standard criteria-related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including but not limited to:
    - i. Kind, size, age, sex, and number of livestock.
    - ii. Diet recommendations to include: type and quantity of feedstuffs to be used.
    - iii. Feed analysis and ration formulation information prior to implementing feed management and after implementing feed management.
    - iv. Manure analysis.
2. Specification sheet provided to the client that adequately describes the requirements to apply the practice and obtain necessary permits.
3. Operation and maintenance plan.
4. Certification that the design meets NRCS practice standard criteria and complies with applicable laws and regulations.
5. Design modifications during application as required.

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**INSTALLATION****Deliverables**

1. Pre-application conference with client and nutritionist.
2. Specification sheet provided to the client that adequately describes the requirements of the practice including:
  - Diet recommendations.
  - Description of kind, size, age, sex and number of livestock
  - Requirements for documenting feed analysis and ration formulation before and after implementing feed management practice.
  - Manure analysis.
3. Application guidance as needed.
4. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original designer.
5. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during application.
6. Certification that the application process and materials meets design and permit requirements.

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**CHECK OUT****Deliverables**

1. Records of application:
  - a. Extent of practice units applied.
  - b. Actual materials used to include: type and amount of feed stuffs.
  - c. Description of actual number, kind, age, sex and size of animals fed.
  - d. Record of feed analysis for all materials used to formulate animals diet.
  - e. Final ration formulation.
  - f. Manure analysis results.
2. Certification that the application meets NRCS standards and specifications and is in compliance with permits.
3. Progress reporting.

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4. Exit conference with client and nutritionist as able.
