

## KARST SINKHOLE TREATMENT

### INSTRUCTION FOR USE OF CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATION 527

#### 1. APPLICABILITY

The work shall consist of treating sinkholes that pose a threat to farm safety or water quality.

This specification does not apply to closure of sinkholes that open into caves.

Location of the sinkhole by latitude/longitude, township/range, or other geo-reference convention, of such precision that it can be readily located in the field, if required, in the future</li> <li>c. Date of sinkhole treatment/closure</li> <li>d. Name of landowner</li> <li>e. Name, title, and address of person responsible for sinkhole treatment/closure</li> </ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>f. Total depth of sinkhole to void, if known</li> <li>g. Approximate inside dimensions of sinkhole</li> <li>h. Types of materials used for filling and sealing, quantities used, depth intervals for placement of each type, and placement method used.</li> <li>i. Safety components (e.g. gates, fencing, warning signs)</li> <li>j. Temporary and permanent vegetative requirements</li> <li>k. Reference to other practice specifications (e.g. PA327, PA342, PA390, PA391, PA393, PA512, etc.), if applicable</li> <li>l. Erosion and sediment control measures</li> <li>m.
