

Operation & Maintenance Plan Access Control (Code 472)

Expected Lifespan

The minimum expected lifespan of this practice is at least 10 years.

A properly operated and maintained <u>Access Control</u> practice is an asset to your farm operation and your agricultural land. Implementation of Access Control will help you to achieve and maintain desired resource conditions by monitoring and managing the intensity of use by animals, people, vehicles, and equipment in coordination with the application schedule of practices, measures, and activities specified in the conservation plan. This practice will require you to perform periodic operation and maintenance to maintain satisfactory performance. The following are some requirements of the operation and maintenance program.

Operation and Maintenance

- Monitoring of the effectiveness of use-regulating activities will be performed routinely and at least annually with changes made to specifications and operation and maintenance requirements as necessary.
- Modifications to activities and use of measures are allowed temporarily to accommodate emergency-level contingencies such as wildfire, hurricane, drought, or flood if resource conditions are maintained.
