

STATEMENT OF WORK Open Channel (582) Vermont

These deliverables apply to this individual practice. For deliverables for other planned practices, refer to those specific Statements of Work.

DESIGN

Deliverables:

- 1. Provide design documentation demonstrating compliance with the criteria in NRCS practice standard and compatibility with other planned and applied practices.
 - a. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan.
 - b. List of required permits to be obtained by the client.
 - c. Impacts on adjacent properties and structures.
 - d. Assure compliance with NRCS national and state utility safety policy (NEM Part 503-Safety, Subpart A Engineering Activities Affecting Utilities 503.00 through 503.06).
 - e. Provide practice standard criteria related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including but not limited to:
 - i. Hydrology/Hydraulics and Appurtenance Design
 - ii. Channel Stability
 - iii. Vegetation and Erosion Control
- 2. Provide written plans and specifications, including sketches and drawings, to the client that adequately describes the requirements to install the practice and obtain necessary permits.
- 3. Provide Design Report and Quality Assurance Plan as appropriate (NEM Part 511, Subpart B Documentation, 511.11 and Part 512-Construction, Subpart D-Quality Assurance Activities, 512.30 through 512.32).
- 4. Provide Operation and Maintenance Plan
- 5. Provide certification that the design meets practice standard criteria and complies with applicable laws and regulations (NEM Part 501- Authorizations, Subpart A-Review and Approval, 501.3).
- 6. Provide design modifications during installation as required.

INSTALLATION

Deliverables

- 1. Pre Installation conference with client and contractor.
- 2. Verify that client has obtained required permits.
- 3. Stake and layout the practice according to plans and specifications, including applicable layout notes.
- 4. Provide quality assurance of installation (according to Quality Assurance plan as appropriate).
 - a. Actual materials used (Part 512, Subchapter D Quality Assurance Activities, 512.33)
 - b. Quality Assurance records
- 5. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original designer.
- 6. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during installation.
- 7. Certification that the installation process and materials meets design and permit requirements.

CHECK OUT

Deliverables

1. As-Built documentation.

- a. Extent of practice units applied
- b. Drawings
- c. Final quantities
- 2. Provide certification that the installation meets NRCS standards and specifications and complies with permits (NEM Part 501-Authorizations, Subpart A-Review and Approval, 501.3).
- 3. Progress reporting.
