A properly operated and maintained <u>Tree and Shrub Site Preparation Practice</u> is an asset to your farm operation and your agricultural land. Implementation of Tree and Shrub Site Preparation will help you to achieve and maintain desired resource conditions by providing treatment of areas to improve site conditions for establishing trees and/or shrubs.

This practice will require you to perform periodic operation and maintenance to maintain satisfactory performance. The following are some requirements of the operation and maintenance program.

Operation and Maintenance

- Maintain erosion control measures as necessary.
- Control locally invasive and noxious plants as necessary. If pesticides are used, refer to the standard Brush Management 314.
- Access by vehicles or equipment during or after site preparation shall be controlled to minimize erosion, compaction and other site impacts. Refer to the standard Access Control 472.
