Expected Lifespan

The minimum expected lifespan of this practice is at least 1 years.

A properly operated and maintained <u>Waste Recycling Practice</u> is an asset to your farm operation and your agricultural land. Implementation of Waste Recycling will help you to achieve and maintain desired resource conditions by supporting one or more of the following purposes:

- Protect or improve the quality of natural resources and the environment,
- · Provide or reduce energy use.

This practice will require you to perform periodic operation and maintenance to maintain satisfactory performance. The following are some requirements of the operation and maintenance program.

Operation and Maintenance

- Records shall be kept for a period of at least five years, and include when appropriate:
 - The dates and quantities of waste imported to or exported from the agricultural production system.
 - Analysis of critical waste characteristics.
 - A description of how the waste recycled and the conservation benefit achieved.
- The following table provides planned dates for periodic inspections and maintenance of equipment and facilities used in recycling of the waste.
