

STATEMENT OF WORK Waste Recycling (633) Vermont

DESIGN

Deliverables

- 1. Design documents that demonstrate criteria in NRCS practice standard have been met and are compatible with planned and applied practices
 - a. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan.
 - b. List of required permits to be obtained by the client
 - c. Practice standard criteria-related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including but not limited to:
 - i. Results of applicable sampling, analyses and tests provided by the client
 - ii. Planned waste utilization
 - iii. Additional requirements applicable to manure or organic materials, non-point source pollution, soil condition, and air quality
- 2. Written plans and specifications including sketches and drawings shall be provided to the client that adequately describes the requirements to implement the practice and obtain necessary permits.
- 3. Operation and maintenance plan
- 4. Certification that the design meets practice standard criteria and comply with applicable laws and regulations
- 5. Design modifications during implementation as required

INSTALLATION

Deliverables

- 1. Pre-application conference with client
- 2. Verification that client has obtained required permits
- 3. Staking and layout according to plans and specifications including applicable layout notes
- 4. Application guidance as needed
- 5. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original designer
- 6. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during installation
- 7. Certification that the application process and materials meets design and permit requirements

CHECK OUT

Deliverables

- 1. Records of application
 - a. Extent and location of practice units applied
 - b. Actual materials used
- 2. Certification that the application meets NRCS standards and specifications and is in compliance with permits
- 3. Progress reporting
