DEFINITION

Established lanes or travel ways that facilitate animal movement.

PURPOSE

Provide or improve access to forage, water, working/handling facilities, and/or shelter,
Improve grazing efficiency and distribution, and/or
Protect ecologically sensitive, erosive and/or potentially erosive sites.
Trails or walkways are often needed when animal movement is impeded or restricted because of steep rough terrain, rock outcrops, dense vegetation, water, etc.
CRITERIA

Trails and walkways should be located away from watercourses using a filter strip

OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

 Periodic grading or re-shaping trails or walkways to maintain designed grade, dimensions, and water movement. 			
Periodic addition of surfacing materials.
