

STATEMENT OF WORK

DESIGN

Deliverables:

1. Design documents that demonstrate criteria in Florida NRCS practice standard have been met and are compatible with planned and applied practices
 - a. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan.
 - b. List of required permits to be obtained by the client and regulations to be met
 - c. List of facilitating practices
 - d. Practice standard criteria-related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including but not limited to:
 - i. Targeted emissions and source
 - ii. Required emission reduction
 - iii. Reduction calculations, analysis, etc.
 - iv. Erosion calculation as needed
2. Written plans and specifications including sketches and drawings shall be provided to the client that adequately describes the requirements to install the practice and obtain necessary permits.
3. Operation and maintenance plan
4. Certification that the design meets practice standard criteria and comply with applicable laws and regulations
5. Design modifications during installation as required

INSTALLATION

Deliverables

1. Pre-installation conference with client
2. Verification that client has obtained required permits
3. Installation guidance as needed
4. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original designer
5. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during installation
6. Certification that the installation process and materials meets design and permit requirements

CHECK OUT

Deliverables / Practice Certification and Check-out Requirements

1. Records of application for certification:
 - a. Purpose for which this practice is applied
 - b. Air quality issue addressed
 - i. type(s)
 - ii. kind(s) (e.g., particulate matter, odors, greenhouse gases etc)
 - c. Baseline condition prior to applying practice
 - d. Amount of improvement to air quality concern achieved
 - e. Location of supporting practices used to address the air quality concern(s)
2. Certification that the application meets Florida NRCS standards and specifications and is in compliance with permits
3. Progress reporting
