

**STATEMENT OF WORK**  
**Recreation Area Improvement (562)**  
**Florida**

**These deliverables apply to this individual practice. For other planned practice deliverables refer to those specific Statements of Work.**

## **DESIGN**

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### **Deliverables:**

1. Design documents that demonstrate criteria in Florida NRCS practice standard have been met and are compatible with planned and applied practices
  - a. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan.
  - b. List of required permits to be obtained by the client
  - c. Practice standard criteria-related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including but not limited to:
    - i. Determination of the vegetation to be retained and vegetation to be established
    - ii. Timing and method of removal for vegetation to be eliminated, including precautions to prevent the spread of any diseases present in the vegetation removed
    - iii. Mitigation of human and wildfire hazard, erosion, runoff, soil compaction and soil displacement to acceptable levels.
2. Written plans and specifications including sketches and drawings shall be provided to the client that adequately describes the requirements to install the practice and obtain necessary permits.
3. Documentation of needed operation and maintenance.
4. Certification that the design meets practice standard criteria and comply with applicable laws and regulations.
5. Design modifications during installation as required

## **INSTALLATION**

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### **Deliverables**

1. Pre-installation conference with client and contractor
2. Verification that client has obtained required permits
3. Staking and layout according to plans and specifications including applicable layout notes
4. Application guidance as needed
5. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original designer
6. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during installation
7. Certification that the application process and materials meets design and permit requirements.

## **CHECK OUT**

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### **Deliverables / Practice Certification and Check-out Requirements**

1. Records of application for certification
  - a. Acres treated
  - b. Type of treatment
  - c. Seedbed preparation
  - d. Species seeded
  - e. Seeding rates
  - f. Date of seeding
2. Certification that the installation meets Florida NRCS standards and specifications and is in compliance with permits
3. Progress reporting
