Subject: IOWA FORAGE AND LIVESTOCK BALANCE WORKSHEET

This technical note provides guidance on how to access the Iowa Forage and Livestock Balance Worksheet and Grazing Plan. This computer program can be used to assist in developing plans for grazing systems in the conservation planning process. This program will provide an estimate to the landowner so he/she will know whether the grazing system will provide an adequate amount of forage for the grazing animals. It will also identify when there are potential forage surplus and deficits. Forage yields are based upon the current forage yield tables from the National Soils Information System (NASIS).

The grazing plan portion of the program provides an opportunity for the conservation planner to document decisions made by the producer. The conservation planner can use the prepared narratives or edit them as needed.
