Notes: These are the maximum amounts to be paid depending upon the landowner's cost statement. All of these programs require the landowner to incur costs before payments are made, i.e. programs reimburse landowners. Practices must be prescribed in an FDA management plan, to qualify for FDA cost share.

FDA ONLY:

PREPARATION OF

MANAGEMENT PLANS, 75% c/s, FOREST PLANS \$7/ac, TREE PLANTING PLANS = \$4/AC (Includes direct seeding and natural regeneration).

Fencing: Woven Wire \$12/Rod, Barbed Wire \$11/Rod, Suspension \$6/Rod, High Tensile \$9/Rod

Other cost share practices include wildlife damage control and fire breaks. Check with your District Forester or call Dan Schmoker at 217/782-2361.

^{1/}Co-cost sharing after February 19, 2000 will be calculated as follows: owner's costs x federal c/s%, not to exceed XX dollars then owner's unpaid balance x FDA c/s% (= federal c/s%), not to exceed basis total (100%). See examples 1, 2, 3 attached.

^{2/}CP22 practice not eligible for FDA co-cost share after February 19, 2000

^{3/}Purchased seed rate for FDA is pending approval.

^{4/}Mechanical vegetation control can be substituted for herbicides at the same rates.
