

CLAY COUNTY - DESIGNATED CRITICAL HABITATS

BALD EAGLE - *Haliaeetus leucocephalus* (Linnaeus, 1766)

Status: Threatened in Kansas

Threatened Nationally

Currently, the following areas are designated critical for bald eagles:

All listed stream corridors have outermost boundaries that are along a line 100 yards landward from the stream's ordinary high water mark on each bank.

- (1) All lands and waters within a corridor along the main stem of the Republican River from its point of entry at the Cloud/Clay County border (Sec. 7-T6S-R1E) to its point of entry at Milford Reservoir (Sec. 12-T9S-R3E).
- (2) All lands and waters that lie within 5 air miles of public lands at Milford Reservoir.
