

MARION COUNTY - DESIGNATED CRITICAL HABITATS

BALD EAGLE - *Haliaeetus leucocephalus* (Linnaeus, 1766)

Status: Threatened in Kansas
Threatened Nationally

Currently, the following areas are designated critical for bald eagles”

All lands and waters that lie within 5 air miles of public lands at Marion Reservoir.

TOPEKA SHINER - *Notropis topeka* (Gilbert, 1884)

Status: Threatened in Kansas
Endangered Nationally

Currently, the following areas are designated critical for the Topeka shiner:
