OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE	
Review and update the plan periodically to incorporate new IPM technology, respond to cropping system and pest complex changes, and avoid the development of pest resistance.	
Maintain conservation treatment requirements identified above to ensure continued effectiveness.	
Develop a safety plan for individuals exposed to chemicals, include telephone numbers and addresses of emergency treatment centers and the telephone number for the nearest poison control center. The National Pesticide Telecommunications Network (NPTN) has non-emergency information: 1-800-858-7378, 7 days, 6:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Pacific Time. Rocky Mountain Poison Center, Montana 1-800-222-1222.	
For assistance with agrochemical spills , call the Montana Department of Environmental Quality 1-406-444-0379. The National 24-hour CHEMTREC telephone number is 1-800-424-9300. The Montana Department of Environmental Quality Emergency Services (DES) 24-hour phone number is 1-406-841-3911 or 1-406-431-0014. The National Response Center (NRC) is 1-800-424-8802.	
Follow label requirements for mixing/loading setbacks from wells, intermittent streams and rivers, natural or impounded ponds and lakes, or reservoirs. Load and mix pesticides at least 100 feet away from wells, high runoff areas, ponds, lakes, streams, and other water bodies or other hydrological sensitive areas. Consider chemical interaction with other species. Handle all pesticides with caution , and wear appropriate protective clothing according to the label instructions.	
Post signs according to label directions and/or Federal, State, and local laws around treated sites. Follow restricted entry intervals.	
Dispose of pesticides and containers according to label directions and Federal, State, and local regulations.	
Maintain appropriate Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) available at http://www.greenbook.net .	
Calibrate application equipment according to Extension and/or manufacturer recommendations before each seasonal use and with each major chemical change.	
Replace worn nozzle tips, cracked hoses, and faulty gauges.	
Recommendations of Pesticides are made by MSU Cooperative Extension Service, Consultants, and herbicide dealers. NRCS does not make specific pesticide recommendations.	
Maintain records of pesticide application for restricted use materials for at least two years. Pesticide application records shall be kept in accordance with USDA Agricultural Marketing Service's Pesticide Recordkeeping Program which is found at http://www.ams.usda.gov/science/sdpr.htm .
