


APPENDIX A

NORTHERN BOBWHITE QUAIL RANGE IN NEBRASKA



All areas located east of the black line are suitable for establishing field borders designed to benefit bobwhite quail habitat. In addition, areas within ½ mile of the following rivers or streams located west of the black line would be suitable to provide benefits to bobwhite quail:

- Frenchman River in Chase County
- Republican River in Dundy County
- North and South Platte and Platte Rivers in Keith and Lincoln Counties
- South Platte River in Deuel County
- North Platte River in Morrill and Garden Counties
- Niobrara River in Keya Paha, Brown, Rock, Boyd, and Holt Counties
- Elkhorn River in Holt County (only east of Highway 281)
- South Loup River in Logan County
- Dismal River and Middle Loup River in Thomas and Blaine Counties
- North Loup River in Blaine, Loup, and Garfield Counties
- Calamus River in Loup and Garfield Counties
- Cedar River in Garfield and Wheeler Counties
- Beaver Creek in Wheeler County
