

STATEMENT OF WORK
Heavy Use Area Protection (561)

These deliverables apply to this individual practice. For other planned practice deliverables refer to those specific Statements of Work. DESIGN

Deliverables:

1. Design documents that demonstrate criteria in NRCS practice standard have been met and are compatible with planned and applied practices.
 - a. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan
 - b. List of required permits to be obtained by the client
 - c. Compliance with NRCS national and state utility safety policy (NEM Part 503-Safety, Subpart A - Engineering Activities Affecting Utilities 503.00 through 503.06)
 - d. Practice standard criteria-related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including but not limited to:
 - i. Type of traffic, design load, site foundation
 - ii. Kind of surface treatment including vegetation measures
 - iii. User safety
 - iv. Additional requirements for livestock and recreation areas
2. Written plans and specifications including sketches and drawings shall be provided to the client that adequately describes the requirements to install the practice and obtain necessary permits.
3. Preparation and documentation of the operation and maintenance plan.
4. Certification that the design meets PA practice standard criteria and comply with applicable laws and regulations.
5. Design modifications during installation as required.

INSTALLATION

Deliverables

1. Pre-application conference with client.
2. Verification that client has obtained required permits.
3. Staking and layout according to plans and specifications including applicable layout notes.
4. Application guidance as needed.
5. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original designer.
6. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during installation.
7. Certification that the PA application process and materials meet design and permit requirements.

CHECK OUT

Deliverables

1. Records of application.
 - a. Extent of practice units applied
 - b. Actual kinds of surface treatments used and applied
2. Certification that the application meets NRCS PA standards and specifications and is in compliance with permits.
3. Progress reporting.
