**STATEMENT OF WORK**

**AGRICHEMICAL HANDLING FACILITY (309)**

**These deliverables apply to this individual practice. For other planned practice deliverables refer to those specific Statements of Work.**

**DESIGN**

*All design documents shall be developed in accordance with the requirements of the [NRCS Pacific Islands Area Field Office Technical Guide \(eFOTG\)](#), Section IV, Conservation Practice Standard and Conservation Practice Specification.*

**Deliverables**

1. Design documentation that will demonstrate that the criteria in NRCS practice standard have been met and are compatible with other planned and applied practices
  - a. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan.
  - b. List of required permits to be obtained by the client
  - c. Compliance with NRCS national and state utility safety policy ([NEM Part 503-Safety, Subpart A - Engineering Activities Affecting Utilities 503.00 through 503.06](#))
  - d. List of facilitating practices.
  - e. Practice standard criteria related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including but not limited to:
    - i. *Appropriate Facility size and storage capacity.*
    - ii. *Location with respect to setback, prevailing wind, 100-year flood plain, depth to seasonal high water table, and ingress and egress.*
    - iii. Geology and Soil Mechanics ([NEM Subpart 531a](#))
    - iv. *Structural design of building, foundation, and concrete pad.*
    - v. *Other Structural, Mechanical and Appurtenance design*
    - vi. Maximize Clean Water Diversion.
    - vii. Hydraulic Loading Rate.
    - viii. Environmental Considerations (e.g. location, air and water quality).
    - ix. *Heavy Use Area Protection (561).*
    - x. Vegetation.
2. Written plans and specifications including sketches and drawings shall be provided to the client that adequately describes the requirements to install the practice and obtain necessary permits.
3. Design Report and Inspection Plan as appropriate ([NEM Part 511, Subpart B Documentation, 511.11 and Part 512, Subpart D Quality Assurance Activities, 512.30 through 512.32](#)).
4. Operation and Maintenance Plan. *The Pacific Islands Area Operation and Maintenance Plan, available in Section IV of the Pacific Islands Area (eFOTG), for this practice shall be prepared for and reviewed with the client with the requirements for the operation and maintenance.*
5. Certifications that the design meets practice standard criteria and comply with applicable laws and regulations ([NEM Subpart A, 505.03 \(b\) \(2\)](#)).
6. Design modifications during installation as required.

## INSTALLATION

---

### Deliverables

1. Pre Installation conference with client and contractor.
2. Verification that client has obtained required permits.
3. Staking and layout according to plans and specifications including applicable layout notes.
4. Installation inspection (according to inspection plan as appropriate).
  - a. Actual materials used.
  - b. Inspection records.
5. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original designer.
6. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during installation.
7. Certification that the installation process and materials meet design and permit requirements.

## CHECK OUT

---

### Deliverables

1. As-Built documentation.
  - a. Extent of practice units applied.
  - b. Drawings.
  - c. Final quantities.
2. Certification that the installation meets NRCS standards and specifications and is in compliance with permits ([NEM Subpart A, 505.03 \(c\) \(1\)](#)).
3. Progress reporting.
