

**FSA LIST 1. SD PRACTICE LIST WITH POTENTIAL TO CAUSE EFFECTS
ON CULTURAL RESOURCES (12/2009 UP-DATE)**

Based upon conditions specific to South Dakota, FSA (pursuant to 800.3) and SHPO (verbal concurrence on 9/24/04) have reviewed Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) Conservation Practices and concurred on which undertakings do not have the potential to cause effects on historic properties (because they are a type of activity with foreseeable effects that are minimal or not adverse to cultural resources and not subject to SHPO review), and those which have the potential to cause effects on cultural resources (subject to SHPO review). The following table indicates the potential of each CRP conservation practice to cause effects on historic properties. The categories are as follows:

- A. Conservation practices that are not considered undertakings with the potential to cause effects on historic properties and are not subject to SHPO review are marked "N" below.
- B. Conservation practices considered undertakings with the potential to cause effects on historic properties and that the SHPO must be consulted with on a case-by-case basis are marked "U" below.


