MlA	Millboro silty clay loam, 0 to 3 percent slopes (Prime farmland if irrigated)
MlB	Millboro silty clay loam, 3 to 6 percent slopes (Prime farmland if irrigated)
Nb	Nimbro silty clay loam (Prime farmland if irrigated)
Nc	Nimbro silty clay loam, channeled (Prime farmland if irrigated)
ReA	Ree loam, 0 to 2 percent slopes (Prime farmland if irrigated)
ReB	Ree loam, 2 to 6 percent slopes (Prime farmland if irrigated)
Wt	Witten silty clay (Prime farmland if irrigated)
