OaA	Onita clay loam, 0 to 4 percent slopes (Prime farmland if irrigated)
SdA	Satanta loam, 0 to 2 percent slopes (Prime farmland if irrigated)

TaA	Tilford silt loam, 0 to 2 percent slopes (Prime farmland if irrigated)
