SOIL DESCRIPTION – TECHNICAL

In this subsection each soil series recognized in the county is described. Characteristics of the soil and the material in which it formed are identified for each series. The soil is compared with similar soils and with nearby soils of other series. A pedon, a small three-dimensional area of soil, that is typical of the series in the survey area is described. The detailed description of each soil horizon follows standards in the Survey Manual. Many of the technical terms used in the descriptions are defined in Soil Taxonomy. Following the pedon description is the range of

important characteristics of the soil series in this county.

The technical soil descriptions are referenced to the published soil survey.

If the soil survey is completed, but not yet published. The technical soil descriptions are referenced to the soil survey manuscript. If the soil survey is currently being updated, the technical soil descriptions will be referenced to the soil survey manuscript, when completed.
