A properly operated and maintained streambank is an asset to your farm. This streambank or shoreline protection is designed and installed to stabilize an eroding area. The estimated life span of this installation is at least 10 years. The life of this installation can be assured and usually increased by developing and carrying out a good operation and maintenance program.

Here are recommendations to help you develop a good operation and maintenance program.

OPERATION RECOMMENDATIONS

All settlement or cracks in the soil should be investigated to determine the cause and immediately repaired.

Control livestock access on unfenced areas.
