I. MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS

The following list of items shall be considered when planning the practice. Those items marked with an asterisk shall be recorded as minimum documentation requirements for an applied practice in a conservation plan. Items 5 and 6 are necessary components of a pest management plan; however, it is the responsibility of the producer to develop and document these components.

- *1. *Location.*
- *2. *Extent in acres.*
- *3. *Crop Rotation (if not previously identified in practice 328).*
- *4. *Results of pest management environmental assessments (SPISP, WIN_PST, or others).*
- 5. *Identification of target pests (If enhancing quantity and quality of an agricultural commodity is a primary purpose.)*

- 6. *Recommended methods of pest management (biological, cultural, mechanical, or chemical), including rates, product and form, timing, and application method (if enhancing quantity and quality of an agricultural commodity is a primary purpose.)*
- 7. *Soil Loss.*

II. RECORDING PROCEDURE

The minimum specifications for this practice will be recorded in the conservation plan narrative, Conservation Practice Job Sheet Pest Management (595), or conservation assistance notes.
