



**Comments/Required Action:**

The spring development and pipeline will be placed in a pasture on 6% slopes and 150 feet north of a small intermittent drainage. This landform is considered sensitive for containing precontact Native American archeological sites. The historic archeological site VT-RU-290 is located about 270 the project. This historic site shall be avoided and there shall be no ground disturbance within 100 feet of the small, shallow cellar hole. As current the project will not affect any important archeological sites or properties eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places. Because there disturbance to any archeologically sensitive landforms and because the historic site will be avoided a finding **No Historic Properties Affected** was the planned conservation practice. Additional cultural resource review will be required if the location of the practice is changed or if unexpected arc resources are exposed during construction.
