Just a reminder if you are interested in finding out about cultural resources in any particular area via the State Historic Preservation Division website. Go to

If you are interested in finding out if any work has been done in a particular area, go to the above web site:

1. on their home page, click on **Inventory of Historic Properties** in the 3rd paragraph.
2. When you get to the next page, click on **Geographic Information Systems** in the 3rd paragraph.
3. On this next page, click on **Select a Geographic Area to Narrow Your Search**.
4. **Select an Island**.
5. Click on a tax map zone.
6. On this page, move down to the TMK line and enter a number for the tax map section you are interested in. The numbers you see are for the Taxation District followed by a Zone number. You enter the **Section** number. It cannot go to a particular parcel or plat.

You will get a listing of previous archaeological work (bibliography) that has been done in that area. Look through for your particular TMK to see if the area you are interested in has been previously surveyed.

I use this site to get basic information. And follow up if need be.
