Fa	Falaya silt loam, 0 to 1 percent slopes, occasionally flooded
Fe	Forestdale silty clay loam, 0 to 1 percent slopes (Prime farmland if drained)
Fn	Fountain silt loam, 0 to 1 percent slopes (Prime farmland if drained)
Iu	Fontaine silt loam, 0 to 3 percent slopes
Ja	Jackport silty clay loam, 0 to 2 percent slopes (Prime farmland if drained)
