IrB	Izagora fine sandy loam, 0 to 4 percent slopes, occasionally flooded
LcA	Lucedale loam, 0 to 1 percent slopes
LcB	Lucedale fine sandy loam, 1 to 5 percent slopes
MaA	Malbis loam, 0 to 1 percent slopes
MaB	Malbis fine sandy loam, 1 to 5 percent slopes
MaC	Malbis fine sandy loam, 5 to 8 percent slopes
