



Source Data for the Official Soil Survey

Duplin County - General

The traditional final product of first generation soil survey mapping has been the soil survey publication. Each publication includes soil map unit descriptions, series descriptions, tables of information (attributes), and maps. One copy of this publication is retained at the NRCS Field Office and is designated as the "Official Copy." This official copy was established to maintain the most current soils information for a survey area.

The 1959 Duplin County soil survey is out-of-date and is the only modern publication available. An unpublished update of Duplin County was completed in the 1980s and remains the official source of soil maps.

The official source of soil data is the NASIS database. The NASIS data are available from this site in a Microsoft Access data template. The file name is the county FIPS code with a "zip" extension, nc061.zip. It may be downloaded and unzipped. The template, nc061.mdb, requires Microsoft Access 97 or newer.
