## Source Data for the Official Soil Survey

### **Cleveland County - General**

The traditional final product of first generation soil survey mapping has been the soil survey publication. Each publication included soil map unit descriptions, series descriptions, tables of information (attributes), and maps. One copy of this publication is retained at the NRCS Field Office and is designated as the "Official Copy." This official copy was established to maintain the most current soil information for a survey area.

The Cleveland County soil survey is not yet published, but it remains the official source of soil maps. The soil survey publication is in draft format. The soil maps are in the process of being digitized and will be available at no charge from this web site. The official source of soil data is the NASIS database.
