## **NATIONAL HANDBOOK OF CONSERVATION PRACTICES - NEW YORK**

### **NOTICE 104**

This notice transmits the following two New York standards:

- Subsurface Drain (NY606)
- Riparian Forest Buffer (NY391)

NY606 transfers the criteria contained in the New York 606 Supplement (6/85) into the current National 606 standard, therefore creating a New York Standard. There is therefore no significant change in the standard, merely conformation to the policy of eliminating supplements.

NY391 reverts to the National 391 standard, with the addition, taken from the current NY391 (8/97) standard, of the criteria allowing for a 100-200 foot Zone 3 for wildlife purposes. The other information eliminated from the now old NY391 was specification information not appropriate to a standard.

**File:** Log this notice on the New York Directives Tabulation Sheet and file it in the front of the NHCP. Make Pen and Ink changes on the "Green Contents" to add these new standards and issue dates. File the attached standards alphabetically in the appropriate location. Remove and destroy the standards and/or supplements they replace.
