INTRODUCTION

In Nebraska, Hydrologic Unit Boundaries have been digitized and coded to the 11-Digit level. For recording purposes, the 3-digit County Fips Code has been added to the end of the current 11-Digit hydrologic unit code to obtain a pseudo 14-Digit Hydrologic Unit Code.

Maps have been generated on poster size paper for each county in Nebraska. These maps are on file in the field office with responsibility for the county. Where a county is divided among two offices, each office will have a copy of the county map.

Maps are to be folded and filed behind the Introduction or displayed in an appropriate location in the field office.
