

ALLEN COUNTY - DESIGNATED CRITICAL HABITATS

BUTTERFLY MUSSEL - *Ellipsaria lineolata* (Rafinesque, 1820)

Status: Threatened in Kansas

Currently, the following areas are designated critical for the butterfly mussel:

- (1) The main stem of the Neosho River from US-54 in Allen County (Sec. 34-T24S-R18E) to the Allen/Neosho County border (Sec. 32-T26S-R18E).

COMMON MAP TURTLE - *Graptemys geographica* (LeSueur, 1817)

Status: Threatened in Kansas

Currently, the following areas are designated critical for the common map turtle:

- (1) The main stem of the Marmaton River from Moran (Sec. 36-T24S-R20E) to the Allen/Bourbon County border (Sec. 11-T26S-R21E).

FLAT FLOATER MUSSEL - *Anodonta suborbiculata* (Say, 1831)

Status: Endangered in Kansas

Currently, the following areas are designated critical for the flat floater mussel:

- (1) All oxbow lakes within the following described land parcels (NE 1/4 Sec. 32 and N 1/2 and SE 1/4 Sec. 33-T26S-R18E).

FLUTEDSHELL MUSSEL - *Lasmigona costata* (Rafinesque, 1820)

Status: Threatened in Kansas

NEOSHO MADTOM - *Noturus placidus* (Taylor, 1969)

Status: Threatened in Kansas

Threatened Nationally

NEOSHO MUCKET MUSSEL - *Lampsilis rafinesqueana* Frierson, 1927

Status: Endangered in Kansas

OUACHITA KIDNEYSHELL MUSSEL - *Ptychobranhus occidentalis* (Conrad, 1836)

Status: Threatened in Kansas

RABBITSFOOT MUSSEL - *Quadrula cylindrica cylindrica* (Say, 1817)

Status: Endangered in Kansas

Currently, the following areas are designated critical for the flutedshell, Neosho mucket, Ouachita kidneyshell, and rabbitsfoot mussels, and the Neosho madtom:

- (1) The main stem of the Neosho River from the Woodson/Allen County border (Sec. 11-T24S-R17E) to the Allen/Neosho County border (Sec. 32-T26S-R18E).
