

## MARSHALL COUNTY - DESIGNATED CRITICAL HABITATS

**TOPEKA SHINER** - *Notropis topeka* (Gilbert, 1884)

Status: Threatened in Kansas  
Endangered Nationally

Currently, the following areas are designated critical for the Topeka shiner:

North Elm Creek and its tributaries in Marshall County from where it enters the Big Blue River (Sec. 14, T1S, R7E) upstream to its headwaters (Sec. 19, T1S, R9E).
