DEFINITION

Above Ground Multi-outlet Pipeline is aluminum or polyvinyl chloride pipe with closely spaced gates installed as part of a surface irrigation system.

PRACTICE INFORMATION

The purpose of the practice is to efficiently convey and distribute irrigation water to the land surface without causing excessive

erosion, water loss, or reduction in water quality.

The gated pipe and appurtenances of the delivery system must be designed and have adequate capacity to deliver the required flow.
