Background: Virginia is participating in a national 3-year pilot to test the validity of potential conservation benefits of the seasonal high tunnel system through the EQIP program. At the national level, the Ecological Sciences Division has developed an interim conservation practice standard for seasonal high tunnel system, which will be utilized in Virginia. The interim standard will be used to serve as a mechanism for field testing the new technology to address resource concerns.
