Records maintenance is required to achieve the intended function, benefits, and life of the practice. The landowner/operator is responsible to establish and implement a groundwater monitoring program. Water testing records that shall be maintained will include:

- 1. Sample site, location, and depth
- 2. Remotely-sensed or in-situ records of water quality conditions within the well (pH, conductivity, turbidity, etc.)
- 3. Date and time water sample taken
- 4. Name and title of person who collected sample
- 5. Type of sampler and sample taken
- 6. Standard collection procedure followed
- 7. Water test analysis date
- 8. Laboratory performing the analysis
- 9. Tested Contaminants
- 10. Test Results
- 11. Schedule of additional testing at required frequency according to applicable standard
- 12. Records to evaluate trends and the effects of any remedial actions to produce water of sufficient quality for the intended purpose
- 13. Rainfall data
- 14. Observations on well condition
- 15. Other records as required
