

## **STATEMENT OF WORK Filter Strip (393) Virginia**

**These deliverables apply to this individual practice. For other planned practice deliverables, refer to those specific Statements of Work.**

### **DESIGN**

---

#### **Deliverables:**

1. Design documentation that will demonstrate that the criteria in the NRCS practice standard have been met and are compatible with other planned and applied practices:
  - a. Identify, discuss and document client needs, and recommend method of resolution.
  - b. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan.
  - c. List of required permits to be obtained by the client.
  - d. List of associated practices (conservation practice name and number).
  - e. Practice standard criteria-related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including but not limited to:
    - i. Strip width, length and percent slope.
    - ii. Size and percent slope of area contributing runoff to the filter strip.
    - iii. Vegetative species selection.
    - iv. Erosion calculations.
2. Written plans and specifications, including sketches and drawings, shall be provided to the client that adequately describe the requirements to install the practice and obtain necessary permits. Plans and specifications shall be developed in accordance with the requirements in the Filter Strip (393) conservation practice standard.
3. Operation and Maintenance Plan.
4. Certification that the design meets NRCS standards and specifications and is in compliance with permits (NEM VA505.03, Amendment VA-18).

### **INSTALLATION**

---

#### **Deliverables:**

1. Pre-installation conference with client.
2. Verification that client has obtained required permits.
3. Staking and layout according to plans and specifications, including applicable layout notes.
4. Installation guidance as needed.
5. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original designer.
6. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during application.

### **CHECK OUT**

---

#### **Deliverables:**

1. Records of installation
  - a. Extent of practice units applied.
  - b. Actual plant materials used.
2. Certification that the installation meets NRCS standards and specifications and is in compliance with permits (NEM VA505.03, Amendment VA-18).
3. Progress reporting.
