

Part 541 - Drafting and Drawings

AL541.3 Title Blocks

A. A drawing number shall be placed in the block in the lower right corner of the title block for all project-type construction and vegetative drawings. This number should be placed on the drawings no later than the time the drawings are sent out for final review. One number will be assigned to each set of drawings and placed on each sheet.

The format of the number will be AL-XXX-XXX-XXX.

AL - abbreviation for Alabama.

The first three digits - discipline (Ex: ENG or ECS).

The next three digits - Code for the conservation practice standard the drawing pertains to. (Ex: Pond drawing would be 378).

The last three digits - sequential number of the drawing.

The drawings shall be numbered consecutively beginning with 001. For example, an engineering drawing for a pond would be AL-ENG-378-001. An ecological sciences drawing for a fence would be AL-ECS-382-001.

The civil engineering technician in the engineering section will be responsible for assigning all drawing numbers and keeping a log of numbers to avoid duplication.
