SECTION III. Conservation Management Systems

F. Conservation Activity Plans Technical Criteria

The Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 (or 2008 Farm Bill) authorized the use of financial assistance funds from the Environmental Quality Incentive Program (EQIP) to develop Conservation Activity Plans (CAPs).

National Bulletin 300-12-7 mandated that all states offer certain Conservation Activity Plans during the FY2012 EQIP sign up. Due to this directive, Alabama is adding 104-Nutrient Management Plan Criteria, 114-Integrated Pest Management Plan Criteria and 130-Drainage Water Management Plan to the Alabama FOTG.

The following Conservation Activity Plan Criteria have been added to Section III of the FOTG:

Nutrient Management Plan Criteria – Code 104
Integrated Pest Management Plan Criteria – Code 114
Drainage Water Management Plan Criteria – Code 130
