## ALABAMA TECHNICAL GUIDE NOTICE 9.

### **SECTION I. General References**

#### **Engineering References, Alabama Engineering Forms**

AL-ENG-27 – Application for Technical assistance for the Design of a Dam and Reservoir or Embankment Type structure

#### **First Page:**

Added Item 2. *“Owner understands that if the dam is constructed for the purpose(s) of livestock water and/or irrigation water and is no longer used for these purposes, permitting of the dam may be required by the Corps of Engineers for Clean Water Act purposes.”*

#### **Second Page:**

The United States and its employees are in no manner a party to any verbal or written contract between the owner and the contractor. NRCS employees (*omitted “within limit of personnel available”*) will assist the owner on inspections as requested during construction to help obtain satisfactory compliance with the drawings and specifications. An NRCS employee will (*omitted “if time permits”*) inspect the keyway (cut-off) and laying of the pipe on all dams upon request of the owner or contractor.

NRCS employees will also (*omitted, “upon reasonable notice”*) participate in a final inspection to help determine that the structure was constructed in accordance with the drawings and specifications. Where cost-shared funds are involved, approval of an NRCS employee is required before payment can be made.
