PRACTICE DEFINITION

Retaining, developing or managing wetland habitat for wetland wildlife

PRACTICE PURPOSE

To maintain, develop, or improve wetland habitat for waterfowl, shorebirds, fur-bearers, or other wetland dependent or associated flora and fauna.



PRACTICE INFORMATION

Practice applies to or on adjacent to wetlands, rivers, lakes and other water bodies where wetland associated wildlife habitat can be managed. This practice applies to natural wetlands and/or water bodies as well as wetlands that may have been previously restored (657), enhanced (659), and created (658).
