STATEMENT OF WORK

ALLEY CROPPING

These deliverables apply to this individual practice. For other planned practice deliverables, refer to those specific Statements of Work.

DESIGN (PLANNING REQUIREMENTS)

Deliverables:

1. Complete a minimum of one site visit with client to identify preferences regarding species to plant, supplemental watering, weed control, and site preparation and planting methods, to meet the practice purpose as identified in the overall conservation plan, and inventory/survey site conditions such as topography, existing and planned utilities, structures and fences, which can influence practice design and layout.
2. Develop three copies of a completed Alley Cropping, 311 Conservation Practice Job Sheet (pages 1 through 4), or similar design documents, to provide installation, and operation and maintenance guidance. Provide one copy to the landowner, one copy to the local NRCS office, and retain one copy for the planner. The completed Job Sheet will demonstrate that the plan adequately addresses purpose-specific NRCS planning criteria. The landowner (cooperator) signature is required on page 3 of the Job Sheet prior to practice installation.
3. Complete one visit to the local NRCS Field Office to verify the plan will not have negative cultural resource impacts. Provide a statement in the Additional Specifications and Notes section of page 4 of the Job Sheet, or similar document, to certify the plan addresses potential cultural resource impacts.

INSTALLATION

Deliverables

1. Conduct a pre-application conference with client.
2. Stake and layout according to the plans and specifications provided in the practice Job Sheet or similar documents.

CHECK OUT

Deliverables

3. Conduct a site visit to check out practice completion.
4. Develop three copies of completed page 3 of the practice Job Sheet or similar document and provide one copy to the landowner, one copy to the local NRCS office, and retain one copy for the planner.
5. Record practice completion progress in TechReg according to NRCS policy.
