Re: Transmit Revised Wildlife Habitat Evaluation Guides (WHEGs) and Revised Biology Practice Standards

This Technical Guide Notice (TGN) transmits revised Biology Technical Note Number 8 and a revised index to Biology Technical Notes to the Colorado electronic Field Office Technical Guide (eFOTG). It replaces the existing wildlife habitat evaluation guide models (WHEG) with 9 new models. It also transmits nine revised biology practice standards. The practice standards being revised are: 390-Riparian Herbaceous Cover, 643-Restoration and Management of Rare or Declining Habitats, 644-Wetland Wildlife Habitat Management, 645-Upland Wildlife Habitat Management, 646-Shallow Water Development and Management, 647-Early Successional Habitat Development/Management, 657-Wetland Restoration, 658-Wetland Creation, and 659-Wetland Enhancement.
