Re: Transmit new WIN-PST 3.1.2 pesticide update and bee Toxicity Data viewer procedures, revised Herbaceous Weed Control 315 Job Sheet, and new Woody Residue Treatment 384 Specification Guide, Job Sheet and Statement of Work

SECTION I

Windows Pesticide Screening Tool (WIN-PST) 3.1.2, pesticide database update

1. Click the following WIN-PST pesticide update link and save the zip file to the C:\Program Files\USDA\WIN-PST 3.1 folder.

2. Open Windows Explorer and navigate to C:\Program Files\USDA\WIN-PST 3.1 folder. Right click the file named stelprdb1046649.zip, and then select WinZip, Extract to here.
3. Open WIN-PST 3.1.2. Select Tools, Update Pesticides, on the toolbar. Click the browse button, open the file named WinPstUpdPest 1-31-12.mdb, then click proceed.

4. When Update Pesticides process OK is indicated on the Status line, click close.

Windows Pesticide Screening Tool (WIN-PST) 3.1.2, bee Toxicity Data viewer

1. Open WIN-PST 3.1.2 and select Open New, Toxicity Data, on the toolbar.
2. Select Toxicity Type, Bee, in the lower left corner of the screen, and sort data by Chemical name or PC Code in the lower right corner of the screen.

3. Toxicity ratings of Highly toxic, Moderately toxic and Relatively nontoxic are indicated in the third column from the right.
