DESIGN AND CHECK DATA REQUIREMENTS FOR
CONSERVATION PRACTICE STANDARD
CLEARING AND SNAGGING

Code 326

As a minimum, the following items shall be included in the design folder for Clearing and Snagging:

Survey Record

1. Plan view of area to be cleared and snagged, with dimensions as appropriate
2. Estimate of quantity of material to be removed, and/or type of vegetation to be treated
3. Cross sections and roughness estimates, when needed, for hydraulic computations

Design Record

1. The following statement shall be placed on the drawings:

“For all buried utilities, the excavator shall notify Call-Before-You-Dig (CBYD) at 1-800-922-4455 or www.cbyd.com. It is the responsibility of the excavator to comply with the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes (CGS), Chapter 293, Section 16-346 (Call-Before-You-Dig) before performing any excavation work.”
2. Clearing/snagging limits
3. Disposal methods/area
4. Vegetation plan
5. Quantities
6. O&M Plan

Check Data Record

1. Installation notes recorded in sufficient detail to show that the practice was constructed as designed and /or changes, including:
 - a. area treated
 - b. disposal area cover thickness
 - c. re-vegetated area dimensions
2. Statement as to the acceptability of materials, including:
 - a. remaining vegetation
 - b. seed
 - c. soil amendments
 - d. mulch
