The Town of East Windsor, Connecticut, has concern for certain additional farmlands for production of food, feed, fiber, and forage, even though these lands are not identified as having national or statewide importance. According to the Code of Federal Regulations, title 7 part 657, these lands have been identified by the local agency concerned as *Local Important Farmland* and approved by the signatories below.

64B	Cheshire fine sandy loam, 3 to 8 percent slopes, very stony
64C	Cheshire fine sandy loam, 8 to 15 percent slopes, very stony
73C	Charlton-Chatfield complex, 3 to 15 percent slopes, very rocky
