The following new interim Connecticut (CT) Practice Standard has been posted to the Connecticut electronic Field Office Technical Guide (eFOTG). This addition to Connecticut conservation practice standards is consistent with recent changes in the National Handbook of Conservation Practices (NHCP) and in support of the seasonal high tunnel pilot project in Connecticut. A national bulletin with guidance will be issued soon. Please take the time to review and understand the new standard.

Also note that the name of 634 Manure Transfer is now Waste Transfer. Only the name was changed. The eFOTG was updated.

If you maintain a paper FOTG, please insert the new CT standard *December*, 2009 into Section IV of the FOTG and note the name change to 634.
