

STATEMENT OF WORK
Forage and Biomass Planting (512)

DESIGN

Deliverables:

1. Design documents that demonstrate criteria in the NRCS practice standard have been met and are compatible with planned and applied practices:
 - a. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan.
 - b. List of required permits to be obtained by the client.
 - c. Practice standard criteria related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including but not limited to:
 - i. Required seedbed condition and preparation methods.
 - ii. Soil and seed amendments needed.
 - iii. Variety or origin and amount of each species to be planted.
 - iv. Planting dates and depths and description of planting equipment.
 - v. Instructions as needed for placing different seed types (e.g., fluffy, large, small, slick and dense) in suitable drill boxes.
2. Written plans and specifications including sketches and drawings shall be provided to the client that adequately describes the requirements to install the practice and obtain necessary permits as documented on the 512 Implementation Requirements document.
3. Certification that the design meets practice standard criteria and comply with applicable laws and regulations as documented on the 512 Implementation Requirements document.
4. Design modifications during installation as required.

INSTALLATION

Deliverables

1. Application guidance as needed.
2. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original designer.
3. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during installation.
4. Certification that the application process meets design and permit requirements documented on the on the 512 Implementation Requirements document.

1. Records of application:
 - a. Extent of practice units applied.
